

This tradition has been passed down from generation to generation and to mark the 125th anniversary, the youngest of the handcarving family, Jason O'Reilly, has opened a showroom in Glebe Lane, just off Plunkett Street in Killarney, to showcase the skilled work the business undertake to create customised, hand-crafted headstones. "We have been doing business all over Kerry, Cork, Limerick, Sligo and even Wales," said Jason. He added "Headstones can be carved out of limestone, granite or marble. Black granite is more expensive, but the most economical choice is grey granite. It never gets dirty, unlike limestone, which you would have to clean every year," he says. He added "You can come in with a sketch and we'll carve the headstone exactly the way you want it." O'Reilly Memorials also provide a full graveside service including erecting new headstones, adding new names to an existing headstone and graveside maintenance, including the supply of chipping. "We are one of the very few people who can carve the old Celtic Crosses," added his uncle James, who carved the famous memorial in Castleisland town in honour of noted traditional musician Padraig O'Keefe. Killarney Memorials will be open Saturday 10am to 5pm and Sunday 12 to 5pm and can also open by appointment. For further information, contact Jason O'Reilly at 087-298 2665.



GARDENING OUTLOOK



with John O'Sullivan

FOCUS ON HEDGING

Hedges can make a much more natural background to a garden than a wall or a fence. They can provide shelter and are cheaper and require a small amount of maintenance. Because a hedge allows the wind to filter through it reduces its velocity. Tall or low growing, clipped or informal, there is a hedging plant for every purpose. One thing to remember about a hedge is that it is intended to be a permanent feature in the garden so therefore should be chosen with care and planted in well prepared soil.

To choose the right hedge for your garden here are a few pointers to think about

- 1. The type of soil you have
- 2. How exposed the garden is, i.e. what direction is it facing
- 3. The eventual height and width the hedge will be

4. Does it need to be evergreen When you have chosen the type of hedge that you want its time to prepare the soil. Start preparing the soil by digging thoroughly and forking in some well rotted farmyard manure. Hedges can be planted all year around but the ideal time is between November and March as all hedging plants will be dormant at this time. What that means is when you go to buy your hedging plants they are lifted straight from the ground and are called bare-rooted hedging. This enables you to replant straight back into the ground when you get them home. Just make sure that when planting that the roots are spread out well as this will encourage them to root quickly when the growing season starts. If you have missed the bare rooted season at the end of March you can plant container grown hedging all year around. Next week I will focus on trees.

Know Your Rights: THE YOUTH GUARANTEE DECEMBER 2014

QUESTION

What is the Youth Guarantee?

ANSWER

The Youth Guarantee aims to provide young people under the age of 25 with a good quality offer of employment, education, training or apprenticeship within a short time of leaving education or becoming unemployed. It is an EU initiative developed in response to the youth unemployment crisis across Europe.

In Ireland the Youth Guarantee is being introduced on a phased basis and a range of initiatives were recently announced. Jobseekers under 25 who have been unemployed for over 12 months will be prioritised and given additional support during the Department of Social Protection (DSP) Intreo process for jobseekers.

JobsPlus is an initiative that pays a cash incentive to employers who employ jobseekers on the Live Register. The qualifying period for JobsPlus for jobseekers under 25 has been reduced to four months. It will remain at 12 months for other jobseekers. Eligible young people, who are in the Live Register, will be given certification that they qualify for JobsPlus and they can use this when applying for jobs.

A Youth Developmental Internship (YDI) is currently being put in place. Internships are expected to start from March 2015. The YDI will be aimed at young people aged between 18 and 24 who have little or no experience of work. The YDI is similar to JobBridge but offers more support to interns including a work preparation course and a shorter internship week of 4 days. YDI internships will not be publically advertised. DSP staff will select candidates and refer them for interviews with organisations that have offered internships.

Other activities under the Youth Guarantee include a new Experience Your Europe (EYE) programme which offers sponsored internships in other EU countries, support for jobseekers who want to work in Europe and an apprenticeship programme in Germany. Employment schemes such as Gateway and Tús will have places reserved for young people who are long-term unemployed.

We can all find ourselves struggling with problems at different points in our lives and Counselling can be a great support during these times. Counselling and Psychotherapy are often used interchangeably and there is no clear difference. Both are Talking Therapies or Psychological Therapies. Some people choose to engage in short-term counselling, for others more longer term work is needed. This depends on the issues you want to address. Some people may want to make a slight improvement in their lives, others may wish to deal with many issues. Sometimes further issues can emerge as therapy proceeds. There are various different approaches to Counselling/Psychotherapy; including Humanistic and Integrative, Psychoanalytical, Cognitive Behavioural and Systemic Family Therapy. Health Matters.... With Dr. Michael Molowey SINUSITIS

WHAT IS SINUSITIS?

The sinuses are small, air- filled spaces in the cheekbones and forehead. They produce mucus which drains into the nose through small channels. Sinusitis occurs when these spaces become swollen and inflamed. The most common cause of this inflammation is due to infection.

Sinusitis is a very common infection which can develop over a few days. On most occasions the symptoms will go within a week but it is not uncommon for it to last for 2-3 weeks. Sinusitis persisting for longer than 12 weeks is termed 'chronic' sinusitis.

TRIGGERS FOR SINUSITIS

In most people sinusitis is triggered by a viral illness such as a cold or flu-like illness which may spread to the sinusitis. Most of these will clear themselves with time. Occasionally bacteria may become involved and thus worsening the infection.

Another common trigger for sinusitis is swelling of the nasal passages due to an abnormal immune response. This can occur in response to pollen (hayfever) or dust mites (allergic rhinitis) as well as many other allergens. The natural immune response can be abnormal in pregnancy as well as conditions such as asthma and sarcoidosis which can all lead to sinusitis. Occasionally sinusitis may be caused as a result of obstruction of the draining canals by a polyp or foreign body. In some cases infection may spread to a sinus from an infected tooth.

Smoking is well documented to increase your risk of developing sinusitis.

SYMPTOMS OF SINUSITIS

The most common symptoms of sinusitis are pain and tenderness over the infected sinus. The pain is often worse when bending over. Often suffers may complain of a frontal headache. There may also associated symptoms of a blocked and runny nose with decreased senses of smell and taste. Suffers may feel feverish and have other symptoms such as bad breath, toothache, cough, tiredness or feeling of pressure/fullness behind ears.

TREATMENTS FOR SINUSITIS

Most cases of sinusitis are due to a viral infection. Like with colds, the immune system usually clears the virus and symptoms go within a couple of weeks. In the proportion of people who are suffering from bacterial infection the immune system should clear this also. Therefore it most people antibiotic treatment for sinusitis is not needed.

Antibiotics can also cause side-effects. Side-effects can include diarrhoea, nausea, vomiting, skin rashes and thrush.

However, antibiotics are sometimes useful. Your doctor is not likely to prescribe an antibiotic for a mild bout of acute sinusitis. But a course of antibiotics may be prescribed in some cases, for example:

• If your symptoms are severe or if you are very unwell.

 If you have another illness such as cystic fibrosis, heart problems or a weakened immune system.

• If your symptoms are not settling within 7 days, or are worsening.

Ingredients

Mushrooms

- 12 whole fresh mushrooms 1 tablespoon vegetable oil 1 tablespoon minced garlic 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened 1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1/4 too shoot on ion nourder
- 1/4 teaspoon onion powder

Method

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Spray a baking sheet with cooking spray. Clean mushrooms with a damp paper towel. Carefully break off stems. Chop stems extremely fine, discarding tough end of stems.
- Heat oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add garlic and chopped mushroom stems to the skillet. Fry until any moisture has disappeared, taking care not to burn garlic. Set aside to cool.
- When garlic and mushroom mixture is no longer hot, stir in cream cheese, Parmesan cheese, black pepper, onion powder and cayenne pepper. Mixture should be very thick. Using a little spoon, fill each mushroom cap with a generous amount of stuffing. Arrange the mushroom caps on prepared cookie sheet.
- Bake for 20 minutes in the preheated oven, or until the mushrooms are piping hot and liquid starts to form under caps.

Hi Readers – I hope you all had a very pleasant Christmas and New Year celebrations and enjoyed the holidays. I would also like to thank all of you that submitted photos for this special edition and I hope it brings pleasant memories to all our readers both at home and far away.

IRISH NEW YEAR TRADITIONS:

New Year's Eve, the last night of the old year, was known as Oíche Chinn Bliana (Year's End Night) and Oíche na Coda Móire (The Night of the Great Feast). Candles were again lighted in the windows and it was believed that if you went to bed hungry on New Year's Eve (known as New Year's night) nothing would satisfy your appetite for the rest of the year.

It was also believed that the condition of your house and home on the last day of the year was how it would be for the following 12 months.

On New Year's night, families would remember those who had passed away that year before by setting a place for them at the dinner table and leaving the door unlatched.

Those who were single were advised to place sprigs of mistletoe, holly and ivy leaves under their pillow so they would dream of their future wives and husbands.

The rise or fall of rivers was observed to foretell whether prices would correspond during the ensuing year.

There was no general tradition of bidding goodbye to the old year and welcoming in the new one,

But for Catholics the 1st of January was a holyday and their year began by attending Mass.

LITTLE CHRISTMAS IN IRELAND:

January 5th was called Small Christmas Eve and that night the candles were again lit in each window, children were given a soft drink and biscuits while the man of the house had an alcoholic beverage.

There were some who believed that water turned into wine at midnight because it's the Anniversary of the Wedding Feast at Cana, it was thought to be very unlucky to try and watch it take place.

January 6th the feast of the epiphany was a holy day of obligation for Catholics, the highlight for children was their visit to the crib after Mass to gaze in wonder at the "3 wise men" that had followed a star from the east to bring gifts to baby Jesus.

The day was also known as Nollaig na mBan or Women's Christmas as the hard work of preparing for Christmas and entertaining extra visitors was over. In many areas this was a very special occasion when the women would gather for a special meal - with wine!

The next day, the decorations came down, a last look at the cards and the holly now withered was carefully burned in the fireplace since it was thought to be unlucky to just throw it away. And so ended the season of Christmas in simpler times, when the houses were decorated with holly, the Christmas cards received and inspirational mottos on the walls (usually by Brian O'Higgins) on Christmas Eve, candles were lit on Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, St. Stevens Day, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, and on the eve and day of the Epiphany and a little paper crib held pride of place in every home.

Small children too young to understand the real meaning of Christmas looked forward to the lighting of the candles as it meant soft drinks and minerals afterwards (and in most cases they would not be tasted again for another year) and of course Santy always brought something no matter how small.

WAS SANTY GOOD TO YOU THIS YEAR?

The true story of Santa Claus begins with Nicholas, who was born during the third century in the village of Patara. At the time the area was Greek and is now on the southern coast of Turkey. His wealthy parents, who raised him to be a devout Christian, died in an epidemic while Nicholas was still young. Obeying Jesus' words to "sell what you own and give the money to the poor," Nicholas used his whole inheritance to assist the needy, the sick, and the suffering. He dedicated his life to serving God and was made Bishop of Myra while still a young man. Bishop Nicholas became known throughout the land for his generosity to those in need, his love for children, and his concern for sailors and ships.

Under the Roman Emperor Diocletian, who ruthlessly persecuted Christians, Bishop Nicholas suffered for his faith, was exiled and imprisoned. The prisons were so full of bishops, priests, and deacons, there was no room for the real criminals—murderers, thieves and robbers. After his release, Nicholas attended the Council of Nicaea in AD 325. He died December 6, AD 343 in Myra and was buried in his cathedral church, where a unique relic, called manna, formed in his grave. This liquid substance, said to have healing powers, fostered the growth of devotion to Nicholas. The anniversary of his death became a day of celebration, St. Nicholas Day, December 6th (December 19 on the Julian Calendar).

Through the centuries many stories and legends have been told of St. Nicholas' life and deeds. These accounts help us understand his extraordinary character and why he is so beloved and revered as protector and helper of those in need.

One story tells of a poor man with three daughters. In those days a young woman's father had to offer prospective husbands something of value-a dowry. The larger the dowry, the better the chance that a young woman would find a rich husband. Without a dowry, a woman was unlikely to marry. This poor man's daughters, without dowries, were therefore destined to be sold into slavery. Mysteriously, on three different occasions, a bag of gold appeared in their home-providing the needed dowries. The bags of gold, tossed through an open window, are said to have landed in stockings or shoes left before the fire to dry. This led to the custom of children hanging stockings or putting out shoes, eagerly awaiting gifts from Saint Nicholas. Sometimes the story is told with gold balls instead of bags of gold. That is why three gold balls, sometimes represented as oranges, are one of the symbols for St. Nicholas.

One of the oldest stories showing St. Nicholas as a protector of children takes place long after his death. The townspeople of Myra were celebrating the good saint on the eve of his feast day when a band of Arab pirates from Crete came into the district. They stole treasures from the Church of Saint Nicholas to take away as booty. As they were leaving town, they snatched a young boy, Basilios, to make into a slave. The emir, or ruler, selected Basilios to be his personal cupbearer, as not knowing the language, Basilios would not understand what the king said to those around him. So, for the next year Basilios waited on the king, bringing his wine in a beautiful golden cup. For Basilios' parents, devastated at the loss of their only child, the year passed slowly, filled with grief. As the next St. Nicholas' feast day

approached, Basilios' mother would not join in the festivity, as it was now a day of tragedy. However, she was persuaded to have a simple observance at home—with quiet prayers for Basilios' safekeeping. Meanwhile, as Basilios was fulfilling his tasks serving the emir, he was suddenly whisked up and away. This is the first story told of St. Nicholas protecting children which became his primary role in the West.

Another story tells of three theological students, traveling on their way to study in Athens. A wicked innkeeper robbed and murdered them, hiding their remains in a large pickling tub. It so happened that Bishop Nicholas, traveling along the same route, stopped at this very inn. In the night he dreamed of the crime, got up, and summoned the innkeeper. As Nicholas prayed earnestly to God the three boys were restored to life and wholeness. In France the story is told of three small children, wandering in their play until lost, lured, and captured by an evil butcher. St. Nicholas appears and appeals to God to return them to life and to their families. Several stories tell of Nicholas and the sea. When he was young, Nicholas sought the holy by making a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. There as he walked where Jesus walked, he sought to more deeply experience Jesus' life, passion, and resurrection. Returning by sea, a mighty storm threatened to wreck the ship. Nicholas calmly prayed. The terrified sailors were amazed when the wind and waves suddenly calmed, sparing them all. And so St. Nicholas is the patron of sailors and voyagers.

Other stories tell of Nicholas saving his people from famine, sparing the lives of those innocently accused, and much more. He did many kind and generous deeds in secret, expecting nothing in return. Within a century of his death he was celebrated as a saint.

Today he is venerated in the East as wonder, or miracle worker and in the West as patron of a great variety of persons-children, mariners, bankers, pawn-brokers, scholars, orphans, labourers, travellers, merchants, judges, paupers, marriageable maidens, students, children, sailors, victims of judicial mistakes, captives, perfumers, even thieves and murderers! He is known as the friend and protector of all in trouble or need.

Sailors, claiming St. Nicholas as patron, carried stories of his favour and protection far and wide. St. Nicholas chapels were built in many seaports. As his popularity spread during the Middle Ages, he became the patron saint of Apulia (Italy), Sicily, Greece, and Lorraine (France), and many cities in Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Italy, Russia, Belgium, and the Netherlands.

Through the centuries St. Nicholas has continued to be venerated by Catholics and Orthodox and honoured by Protestants. By his example of generosity to those in need, especially children, St. Nicholas continues to be a model for the compassionate life.

Widely celebrated in Europe, St. Nicholas' feast day, December 6th, kept alive the stories of his goodness and generosity. In Germany and Poland, boys dressed as bishops begged alms for the poor—and sometimes for themselves! In the Netherlands and Belgium, St. Nicholas arrived on a steamship from Spain to ride a white horse on his gift-giving rounds. December 6th is still the main day for gift giving and merrymaking in much of Europe.

DID YOU KNOW THAT

When it came to celebrating the New Year it seems that everyone had their own peculiar way of doing things. Here are just a few of the strangest New Year's traditions from around the world.

*In Denmark they saved all of their unused dishes and plates until the 31st of December when they affectionately shatter them against the doors of all their friends and family.

*In Ecuador they celebrated the New Year by burning paper filled scarecrows at midnight.

*In Spain, if you could manage to stuff 12 grapes in your mouth at midnight you'd achieved good luck for the next year.

*In some South American countries wearing coloured underwear determined your fate for the New Year. Red underwear meant you'd find love. Gold meant wealth and white signifieed peace.

*In Japan they rang all of their bells 108 times in alignment with the Buddhist belief that this brings cleanness. It's was considered good to be smiling going into the New Year as it brought good luck.

*Every year at the end of December in the small Peruvian village of Takanakuy both women and men fist fight to settle their differences. They then start the year off on a clean slate.

*In Switzerland they celebrated the New Year by dropping ice cream on the floor.

*In Romania they threw their spare coins into the river to get good luck.

*In some parts of Puerto Rico they threw buckets of water out of their windows to drive away evil spirits.

*In Belgium farmers wished their cows a happy new year,

*In Bolivia coins were baked into sweet cakes and whoever found the coins had good luck for the next year.

*The French used consume a stack of pancakes. *In Denmark people climbed on top of chairs and literally "jumped" into the New Year to bring good luck.

*In Germany they used pour molten lead into cold water and the shape that is took predicted the future. Heart shapes symbolised marriage, round shapes good luck; anchor shapes that you needed help, a cross signified someone's sad demise.

HOW TO KEEP YOUR NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTIONS:

If you've resolved to run a marathon, start out by going for a jog two or three times a week. If you are trying to eat healthier, start by replacing some of your favourite junk foods with more nutritious foods. While it may seem like a slow start, these small changes make it easier to stick to your new habits and increase the likelihood of long-term success.

Encountering a setback is one of the most common reasons why people give up on their New Year's Resolutions. If you suddenly relapse into a bad habit, don't view it as a failure. The path toward your goal is not a straight one and there are always going to be challenges. Instead, view relapses as learning opportunities.

If you are keeping a resolution journal, write down important information about when the relapse occurred and what might have triggered it. By understanding the challenges you face, you will be better prepared to deal with them in the future.

It may take longer than you would like to achieve your goals, but remember that this is not a race to the finish. Once you have made the commitment to changing a behaviour, it is something that you will continue to work on for the rest of your life.
